

RESOLUTION TO EXTEND A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSES OF A LARGE-SCALE SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEM FACILITY IN TALIAFERRO COUNTY, GEORGIA

WHEREAS the Taliaferro County Board of Commissioners has determined that in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Taliaferro County, Georgia it is necessary to establish regulations governing the development of large-scale solar energy system facilities within Taliaferro County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS the County desires to review its Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance originally adopted January 2, 2002, and subsequently amended, to determine if any changes are required to better reflect the current building and development standards and to otherwise protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Taliaferro County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the County is still in the process of reviewing said ordinance to determine if any changes are required; and


WHEREAS, the Georgia legislature is currently in session and there are several bills being considered relating to solar energy; and


WHEREAS, the County desires to preserve the current level of large-scale solar energy system facilities within its boundaries during this interim period;


THEREFORE, be it enacted that the moratorium currently in place regarding the development of any property located within Taliaferro County, Georgia for the purposes of constructing a large-scale solar energy system facility shall be extended for a period of 180 days, commencing upon the enactment of this Ordinance.


